Do you have expired drugs or medications you no longer use?

Prescription drug abuse is the fastest-growing drug problem in the nation. Don't risk letting your unwanted or expired drugs and medications get in the wrong hands. Get rid of them!

Drug drop boxes offer a convenient, secure and environmentally safe way to dispose of expired, unused prescriptions or any medications no longer needed.

Drug Drop boxes are located outdoors, in front of all ten Baltimore County police precincts and are accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year.

Acceptable Items for Drop Box

Expired medication, unused or unwanted medication, illegal drugs, over-the-counter medications, liquid medications in a container, pills/capsules in original container or a zip lock baggie, veterinary medications

Unacceptable Items for Drop Box

All medical waste (needles, lancets, syringes, and razor blades) should be securely enclosed in a metal or plastic container and thrown in the regular trash
